By my signature, I affirm that all damages that occur due to the ignition of this fire are my responsibility. I further agree to perform open burning in a safe manner, by following the listed guidelines below:

1. Notification will be made to Pueblo County Sheriff's Communications at 583-BURN (2876) prior to and immediately following all burning activities on the dates permitted.
2. Open burning of rubbish materials containing paper products is prohibited.
3. Open burning shall only be performed during daylight hours and when the following atmospheric conditions are present:
 - a. Wind speed is less than 10 miles per hour.
 - b. Relative humidity greater than 10%.
 - c. Other: _____
4. Open burning shall not be conducted within 50 feet of any structure or other combustible material. Conditions which could cause fire to spread within 50 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition. (307.4)
5. A garden hose connected to a water supply, a shovel, and / or other approved fire-extinguishing equipment shall be readily available at the site of the burning. (307.5)
6. Burning material shall be constantly attended by an adult knowledgeable in the use of fire-extinguishing equipment required above, and familiar with the permit limitations which restrict open burning. (307.5)

This permit may be revoked at any time, and any ongoing burning may be required to be immediately discontinued if it is determined by this office that the burning constitutes a hazardous condition, or that the smoke emissions are offensive to occupants of surrounding property. (IFC 307.1.1)
